## **Purpose**

Federal transit law, as amended by SAFETEA-LU, requires that projects selected for funding under the Elderly Individuals and Individuals with Disabilities (Section 5310), Job Access and Reverse Commute (JARC)/Wisconsin Employment Transportation Assistance Program (WETAP), and New Freedom programs be “derived from a locally developed, coordinated public transit-human services transportation plan” and that the plan be “developed through a process that includes representatives of public, private, and non-profit transportation and human services providers and participation by members of the public.”

This plan meets this requirement while providing guidance to the county and region in providing and improving specialized transportation services over the next five years. This process will update the information compiled from the 2008 Sauk County coordination plan. The plan will concentrate on the effort to attend to transportation needs within Sauk County and to prioritize strategies to address this need.

## **Process**

A county meeting, where a broad range of representatives including citizens with disabilities, social service agencies, transportation providers, insurance providers and Managed Care Organizations, the press, Sauk County Board members and personnel and other interested members of the public, was held on June 30, 2010, with 24 persons in attendance.

The meeting opened with a discussion of the SAFETEA-LU and WisDOT requirements for the plan along with grant opportunities that may be available presented by Wisconsin DOT staff. A presentation of county demographics, including elderly, disabled, and low-income persons, as well as their location and distribution throughout the county was offered. Service gaps were then identified. A wide range of strategies for coordination of services were presented and the group provided input on the need for coordination, and developed strategies to pursue on a local level in the coming years. The final product, this document, includes Sauk County’s goals and action items.

## Identified Gaps

At the Public Meeting on June 30, 2010 several gaps were identified. The group organized the gaps as follows:

- Education Gaps
  - Travel Training
  - Passenger Education about transportation options
  - Integrated transportation – how to use variety of transportation providers
  - How to access funding sources for Medicare beneficiaries
  - Understanding AADA & FTA's adoption of AADA in 2008
    - Programs not accessible
      - Curb-cuts and sidewalk issues
      - Road fund allocations not triggering AADA requirements
  - Understanding ADA standards for multi-county planning
  - Understanding Family Care transportation benefits
  - Understanding how to use MA mileage reimbursement when beneficiaries drive themselves or arrange their own transportation
- Transportation Options/Affordability Gaps
  - Affordable & convenient access to Madison
    - Sharper Vision store
    - Regular & ongoing medical trips: daily for multiple weeks
    - Health Care Center residents for all day appointments
    - Reaching destinations outside Sauk County
  - Assistance with subsidizing taxi fares
  - Shopping trip in Reedsburg and throughout the county
  - Frequent but low volume long distance/remote destination trips – especially for children needing additional care
  - Short notice/urgent/safety risk/emergency ride availability for abuse victims or homeless individuals
- The Bus Route
  - Feeder service for areas more than one mile from the route
  - Access to communities not served
  - Reduced wait times – greater frequency
- Increased Coordination
  - Working with clinics to provide transportation
  - Learning from Menominee tribe service
  - Working with Managed Care Organizations
  - Improving municipal partnerships especially with shared-ride taxi programs
  - Volunteer driver list for short notice trips

## Goals and Action Steps

At the public meeting on June 30, 2010 the following Goals were established and then ranked by vote. Goals are listed here in order most votes received to fewest:

- **Increase transportation options for the transportation disadvantaged**
  - *Action Steps*
    - Increase purchasing power through contracting and consolidation of purchasing with other entities
    - Improve transportation service delivery and increase/improve service productivity
- **Develop/expand/continue transportation services**
  - *Action Steps*
    - Expand services to adjoining counties
    - Analyze new technologies for on-demand transportation services
- **Enhance coordination between transportation providers**
  - *Action Steps*
    - Maximize efficiency and productivity of transportation services through the use of technology
- **Increase consumer awareness of available transportation services**
  - *Action Steps*
    - Develop and improve access to information about transportation services
    - Develop/expand marketing of transportation services

Please find an agenda as well as a worksheet that you can use to help begin thinking about gaps in transportation in Sauk County.

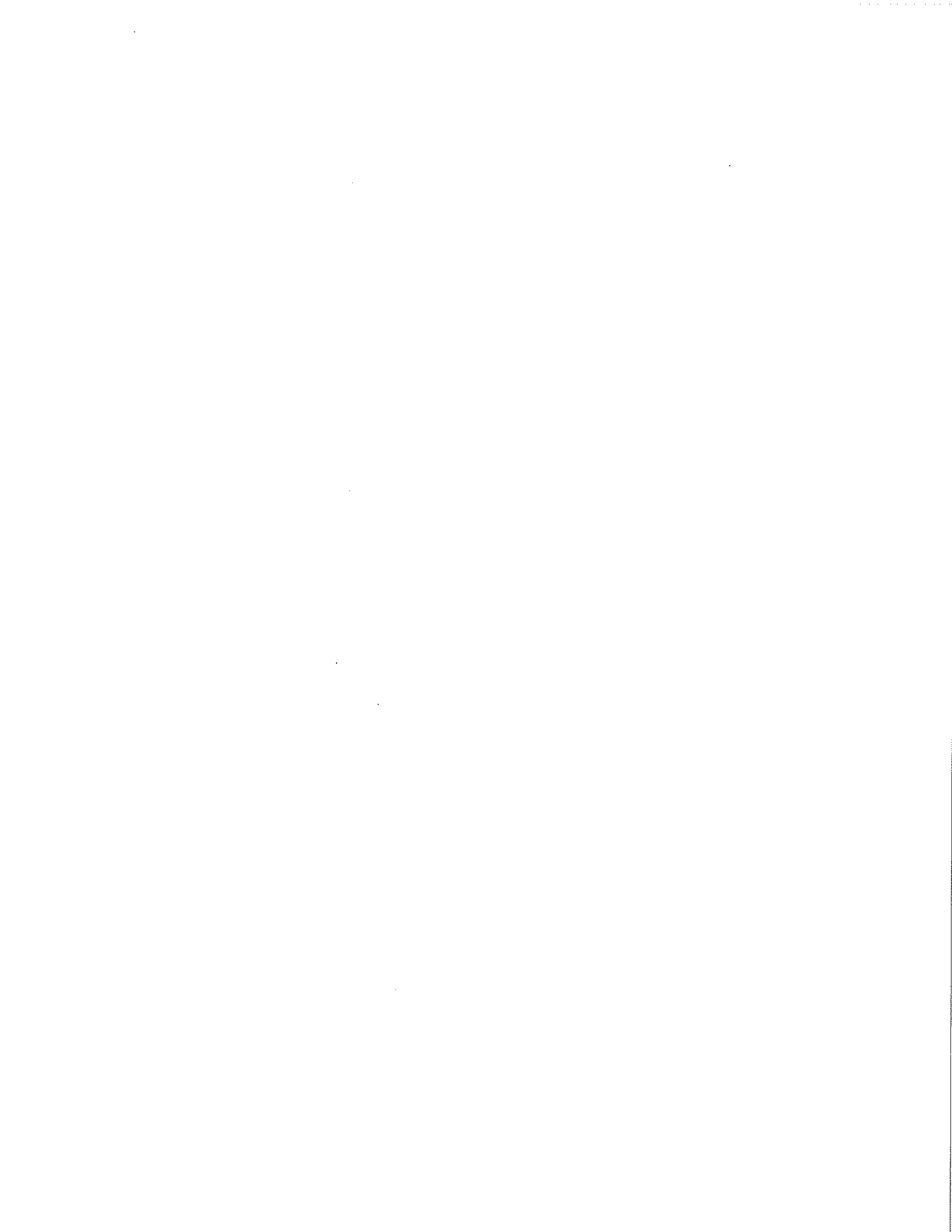
