Public meeting for Tower Avenue in the city of Superior

Meeting to focus on proposed design and streetscape for reconstruction of north Tower Avenue

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) Northwest Region in Superior is announcing a public information meeting to discuss a proposed design alternative for the reconstruction of WIS 35 from Belknap Street to North 3rd Street (Tower Avenue, City of Superior). WisDOT, in partnership with the City of Superior, is offering two opportunities to attend the meeting, scheduled from 12-1:30 p.m. and 5-7 p.m. on Thursday, Feb. 18, 2010 at the Old Post Office, 3rd Floor Courtroom, 1401 Tower Avenue in Superior.

The proposed project would reconstruct Tower Avenue to improve traffic flow and safety for motorists and pedestrians. The purpose of this meeting is to inform the public of the status of design investigations, the proposed alternative and the project schedule. Design concepts to be discussed include the lane configuration or "look" of the final roadway, parking, sidewalk, street lighting, side streets and utilities. This meeting will be the opportunity for public comment on the street scape proposal.

WisDOT and City of Superior representatives will provide a formal presentation followed by discussion about the proposed concepts and proposed alternative displays. The public is encouraged to attend the meeting, provide input and ask questions concerning this project.
