

Defense and Arrest Tactics Instructor

Course Description:

This will be a train-the-trainer program designed to meet the requirements for Defense and Arrest Tactics Instructor certification from the Training and Standards Bureau. The program will follow the LESB training guide.

Topics of Instruction include:

- ✘ How DAAT training fits into the general unified tactical training approach to law enforcement training.
- ✘ How DAAT training is related to the other tactical subjects
- ✘ Review of the key DAAT concepts, which are the basis of unified tactical training.
 - ✘ Proper use and application of force
 - ✘ Disturbance Resolution
 - ✘ Intervention Options
 - ✘ Incident Response
- ✘ Familiarization of the Training and Standards Student and Instructor Manuals for the topic of DAAT
- ✘ Run through and review of the DAAT training curriculum
- ✘ Student Teach Backs

Prerequisite:

- ✘ Wisconsin Certified Law Enforcement Officer
- ✘ Attended or going to attend an Instructor Development Program or equivalency accepted by the Department of Justice Training and Standards- Certification as a DAAT Instructor requires completion of the IDP or DOJ accepted equivalency.
