

Technical Crash 1

June 21-25, 2010

Course Description:

This course is designed to advance the crash investigation skills of law enforcement officers beyond that which they develop in their basic law enforcement training. The primary focus of this class is to prepare the student to properly identify, collect and preserve various types of evidence that is present at the crash scene. There are a number of practical work problems along with field-testing to improve the officer's ability to apply the learned skills to actual crash situations
