

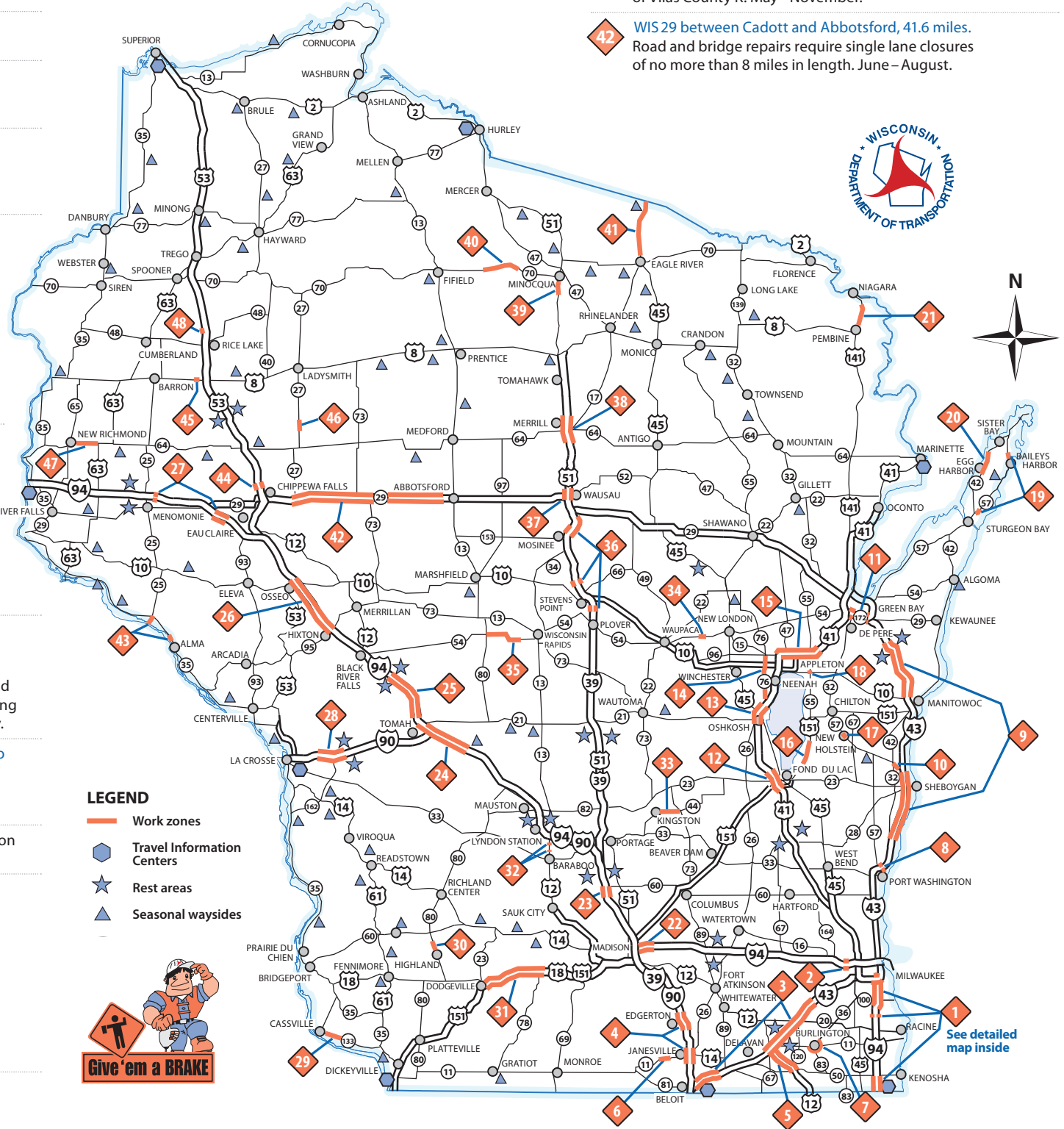
Major work zones for 2009

Other short-term projects may not be listed. It's always wise to slow down and allow additional time for travel through work zones. Remember, fines are double in work zones!

- 1** I-94 from the Illinois state line to the I-94/894/43 (Mitchell) Interchange, 36 miles. In Kenosha County, two lanes open in each direction between the state line and WIS 50. In Racine County, County G Interchange reconstruction may require lane and ramp restrictions. In Milwaukee County, interchange improvements at College Avenue, the westbound airport spur (WIS 119), S. 27th and Layton Avenue may require lane and ramp restrictions. March–December.
- 2** I-94 bridges at Calhoun Road, Waukesha County, 0.5 mile. Bridge work requires 11-foot width restriction, but three lanes are open in each direction. April–September.
- 3** I-43 from Beloit to WIS 140, 6.5 miles and from US 12 to WIS 83, 26.3 miles. Pavement rehabilitation and bridge work requires single lane restrictions at various locations in the corridor. May–November.
- 4** I-39/90 at Janesville, 2 miles, and near Edgerton, 5 miles. Installation of median cable guards and bridge painting require daytime shoulder and nighttime lane closures. July–November.
- 5** US 12 from WIS 50 to WIS 67, 10.8 miles. Pavement repairs require lane restrictions. August–November.
- 6** WIS 11 from just west of Janesville to Footville, 5 miles. Pavement replacement requires lane restrictions. July–September.
- 7** Burlington Bypass, 5.2 miles. Work requires detours for WIS 36 and Racine County P traffic. WIS 36 is detoured via WIS 120 and WIS 11; County P via Market Street, WIS 83 and WIS 50. March–November.
- 8** I-43 at Ozaukee County KK bridges near Port Washington, 0.3 mile. Rehabilitation of bridges restricts traffic to one lane in each direction. July–September.
- 9** I-43 in Sheboygan County, 16 miles and in Manitowoc and Brown counties, 16.5 miles. Pavement and bridge repairs reduce traffic to one lane in each direction, except for Green Bay Packer home games when I-43 will have two lanes open in each direction from five hours before the game to five hours after the game. July–October.
- 10** WIS 42 between Sheboygan and Howards Grove, 4 miles. WIS 42 west of Vanguard Drive is closed with a detour via WIS 32, WIS 23, and I-43. East of Vanguard Drive, watch for lane restrictions and flaggers. April–November.
- 11** WIS 172 between US 41 and I-43 at Green Bay, 5.5 miles. Rehabilitation of pavement, ramps, and bridges requires lane and some ramp closures. Alternate route: US 41 to I-43. February 2009–August 2010.
- 12** US 41 at Fond du Lac, 5 miles. From US 151 Interchange to Military Road, pavement reconstruction and bridge replacement requires lane closures, lane shifts, and short term night detours. Through November. From Military Road to Fond du Lac County OO, resurfacing and bridge redecking requires lane restrictions, closures and shifts. Through July.
- 13** US 41 from WIS 26 to WIS 44, 2.7 miles and from Winnebago County E to Winnebago County Y, 3.5 miles. Pavement repairs require lane width restrictions, lane shifts and nighttime lane closures. July–October.
- 14** WIS 76 from US 41 to WIS 15, 8.7 miles. Road and intersection improvements require lane restrictions. May–September.
- 15** US 41 from WIS 15 to Outagamie County J, 12.3 miles. Pavement, bridge work and installation of cable and beam guards require lane restrictions. Much work is being done at night. Bridges crossing US 41 at Vandebroek Road, Buchanan Road, and Capitol Drive will be closed for approximately 40 days while they're being raised. US 41 at WIS 55 will be down to one lane and the entrance ramp from WIS 55 to northbound US 41 will be closed for three weeks in the spring while work on the WIS 55 and Maloney Road bridges is completed. May–November.
- 16** US 151 from Fond du Lac County WH to the north county line, 9 miles. Pavement and bridge work requires lane restrictions, flaggers, and a short-term detour via Fond du Lac County highways WH and G. May–November.
- 17** WIS 32/57 in New Holstein, 2.1 miles. Pavement repairs require detour via Calumet County J, Calumet County X, WIS 67 and US 151. July–October.
- 18** US 10 at WIS 55, 0.3 mile. Reconstruction closes intersection. US 10 detour is via WIS 114 and WIS 32/57. WIS 55 detour follows WIS 114, Calumet County N and Winnebago County CE. May–September.
- 19** WIS 57 from WIS 42 to Door County P and from Summit Road in Baileys Harbor to Door County Q, 4.7 total miles. Pavement repairs require lane restrictions. Watch for flaggers. March–July.
- 20** WIS 42 from Egg Harbor to Fish Creek, 7 miles. Pavement repairs require lane restrictions. Watch for flaggers. March–July.
- 21** US 8/US 141 from Marinette County R to the north US 141/US 8 split, 8.1 miles. Pavement repairs and addition of passing lanes requires single lane traffic. Watch for flaggers. June–September.
- 22** I-94 at the I-39/90 (Badger) Interchange at Madison, 5.2 miles. Highway improvements with 11-foot width restrictions. Two lanes open in each direction days and evenings. Periodic lane closures will occur during non-peak hours weekdays. No weekend closures. August 2009–November 2011.

- 23** I-39/90/94 from the north Dane County line to WIS 60, 3.9 miles. Pavement replacement shifts all traffic to one side of the median. Two lanes of traffic in each direction with an 11-foot width restriction. April–Memorial Day and Labor Day–November.
- 24** I-90/94 between Camp Douglas and Tomah, 19.3 miles. Pavement and bridge repairs require lane restrictions and, at times, traffic is reduced to one lane in each direction on one side of the median. After Memorial Day, I-90 has one lane closed in each direction while I-94 and I-90/94 have single lane closures between 7 p.m. and 10 a.m. Sundays through Fridays. March 2009–October 2011.
- 25** I-94 between Tomah and Black River Falls, 15.4 miles. Pavement repairs require single lane closures from 6 a.m. Monday to 10 a.m. Friday. April–October.
- 26** I-94 between WIS 95 and Osseo, 15 miles. Pavement repairs require weekday single lane closures between 6 p.m. Monday and 9 a.m. Friday. April–July. Painting of WIS 121 Bridge requires single lane closures between 6 p.m. Monday and 9 a.m. Friday. August–November.
- 27** I-94 at Evergreen Road at Eau Claire and at the Stokke Parkway Bridge at Menomonie, 0.5 mile each. Bridge work requires lane restrictions with one lane in each direction. Evergreen Road: April–June; Stokke Parkway: August–October.
- 28** I-90 from West Salem to the east La Crosse County line, 7.5 miles. Pavement and bridge repairs reduce traffic to one lane in each direction on the same side of the median. March–November.
- 29** WIS 133 between Potosi and Cassville, 8.4 miles. Reconstruction requires detour, which is posted. March–November.

- 36** I-39 Stevens Point to Wausau, 30 miles. I-39 at Porter Road, Stevens Point, traffic reduced to a single lane in each direction weekdays during off-peak hours. Nighttime closures are possible. June–November. New US 10 west interchange at Stevens Point requires weekday lane closures. Through July. Near Mosinee, bridge construction shifts traffic to a temporary road with ramp closures at Maple Ridge Road. June–December. Between WIS 34 and Business 51 at Wausau, northbound traffic will be reduced to one lane weekdays. All lanes open weekends. July–October.
- 37** US 51/WIS 29 in Wausau, 0.7 mile. Construction of US 51 northbound roadway, bridges, interchange ramps, and retaining walls result in periodic weekday lane closures between Sherman St. and WIS 52. Through November.
- 38** US 51 from the north Marathon County line to Lincoln County K, 6.8 miles. Repaving and bridge painting on southbound lanes shift traffic to the northbound lanes and reduce traffic to one lane in each direction. April–June. South of Merrill, bridges over Wisconsin River will be painted, limiting traffic to one lane in each direction. July–October.
- 39** US 51 from Hazelhurst to Minocqua, 5.1 miles. Repaving work reduces traffic to one lane in each direction weekdays. Watch for flaggers. May–June.
- 40** WIS 70 between the Price/Oneida County line and Vilas County F, 10.5 miles. WIS 70 is closed until July 3 with detour via WIS 47, WIS 182, and WIS 13. After July 4, WIS 70 may be reduced to one lane during daylight hours with traffic controlled by flaggers. May–October.
- 41** US 45 from Eagle River to the Michigan state line, 15 miles. Repaving reduces traffic to one lane. Watch for flaggers. Bridge work will reduce road to one lane with signals controlling traffic over Pioneer Creek just north of Vilas County K. May–November.
- 42** WIS 29 between Cadott and Abbotsford, 41.6 miles. Road and bridge repairs require single lane closures of no more than 8 miles in length. June–August.



- 30** WIS 80 between Highland and Iowa County P, 4 miles. Reconstruction requires detour via US 18, Iowa County Q, and WIS 133. County P traffic is detoured via WIS 133 and County N. May–December.
- 31** US 18/151 between Dodgeville and Mount Horeb, 19.4 miles. Pavement repairs limit traffic to one lane in each direction with five-mile long work zones weekdays from Monday mornings through Friday afternoons. All lanes available for weekends. June–December.
- 32** US 12 between Lake Delton and Baraboo, 5.7 miles. Construction of new US 12 affects US 12 traffic at Fern Dell Road and Terrytown Road intersections where the new bypass will connect to existing US 12. WIS 33 is also affected requiring a detour via WIS 136 for a 30-day period during construction. March 2009–November 2011.
- 33** WIS 44 between Kingston and Markesan, 3.7 miles. Reconstruction of WIS 44 closes highway with detour via WIS 73, Green Lake County X and WIS 44. May–September.
- 34** WIS 54 west of New London, 0.4 mile. Bridge replacement closes WIS 54 with detour via WIS 22 and US 45. April–September.
- 35** WIS 54 between Wood County GG and WIS 80, 7 miles. Bridge replacements close WIS 54 with detour via WIS 73, WIS 173, and WIS 80. July–December.

- 43** WIS 35 just north of Alma, 0.2 mile and WIS 25 over the Mississippi River at Nelson, 5 miles. Bridge replacement on WIS 35 reduces traffic to one lane with traffic signals. May–July. On WIS 25, bridge replacement and rehabilitation reduces traffic to one lane with traffic signals. August 2009–October 2010.
- 44** US 53 at Chippewa Falls, 0.5 mile. Bridge painting at Chippewa Falls closes left lane, May–August.
- 45** US 8 at Cameron, 0.1 mile. Redecking of bridge requires detour via Barron County W. June–Labor Day.
- 46** WIS 27 at Holcombe, 1 mile. Bridge work over Fisher River and Holcombe Flowage requires lane restrictions at each location, watch for flaggers. April–October.
- 47** WIS 64 between New Richmond and US 63 south, 7 miles. Pavement and bridge repairs require lane restrictions. Watch for flaggers. Bridge work over Willow River reduces road to one lane with traffic controlled by a signal. May–August.
- 48** US 53 southbound at Barron County SS bridge, 0.2 mile. Repaving bridge reduces traffic to one lane in each direction. June–July.
