

## FINAL END OF SPRING THAW WEIGHT ROAD RESTRICTIONS

The Department of Transportation Spring Thaw and Class II weight restrictions will be lifted in Zone 1 and 2 at 12:01 a.m. on Saturday, May 14, 2011. The restrictions for zones 3, 4, and 5 were lifted previously. Lifting the weight restrictions ends Class II Road limitations temporary less-than-legal weight postings and temporary suspension of divisible load multiple trip permits, such as the permits to transport forest products, vegetables, garbage and recyclable scrap in all Zones. The end of seasonal weight restrictions applies to highways on the State Trunk Highway System ONLY. (This includes all State and US numbered highways within the zones identified.) Year round restriction of divisible load multiple trip permit use of Interstate, except that portion of IH 39 from the IH 90/94 interchange near Portage to the north, remains in effect.
